Social Science (6) <i>Each course must be from a separate discipline (cannot have 2 History courses)</i>	Anthropology, Business, Economics, Agricultural Economics, Geography, History, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Women's Studies		
Pre-Pharmacy Orientation (2) <i>This course is NOT required to apply to the DKICP.</i>	IS 201 <i>Offered at UHH, Spring semester only.</i>
