Contingent upon availability of funds, UH Hilo DKICP may continue providing the award to the selected recipients if they maintain a GPA of 3.5 or higher each semester.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Recipients must be a full-time PharmD student at UH Hilo DKICP
- Must have a minimum overall undergraduate GPA of 3.3. Priority consideration will be given to those with a GPA of 3.5 and above.
- Must have a Bachelor's Degree
- Must be a US Resident
